The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the Japan Civil Aviation Bureau (JCAB) (collectively, the “Authorities”) have agreed to extend the effective implementation date of the FAA-JCAB Implementation Procedures for Airworthiness (IPA) Revision 1 (signed November 1, 2019) from January 30, 2020 to March 30, 2020. The existing IPA (signed April 27, 2009) will remain in effect until said date.

The Authorities acknowledge the unanticipated circumstances and delays that led to the decision to extend this period, and recognize the importance of fulfilling the necessary regulatory requirements to support the proper implementation of the IPA.
